### International Women's Day

### Elphin Sensory Park

If so, you are legally required to meet the advertising standards set out in the Official Languages (Amendment) Act 2021.

Under Section 10A of the Act:

- ♦ 20% of all advertising placed annually must be in the Irish language.
- ♦ 5% of your advertising budget must be spent on Irish language media—defined as media where 50% or more of the content is in Irish
